Nancy	1787?	Brigantine
Rhine	1812	From Skye to Liverpool
Aid	1819	From Riga to Londonderry. Cargo of flax. Struck rock out of harbour
Pacific	1823	From Limerick to Liverpool. Stranded at Scalpay
Molly	1826	Sank near lighthouse.
Robert Garden	1828	Schooner
?	1836	Capsized.
Harmony	1839	Schooner. From Wick to Ireland.
Hope	1839	Ran ashore on Scalpay
Vino	1839	Struck rocks off Scalpay
Methven Castle	1840	Schooner. From Stettin to Liverpool. Struck <i>Sgeir Graidich</i> .
Paulina	1840	Barque. From Danzig to Belfast. Struck rock off Scalpay.
?	1843	Brigantine. Struck (?) <i>Sgeir Graidich</i> off Scalpay
?	1847	Russian. Cargo of tallow & iron. Struck rocks off Scalpay
Ketty	1847	Sank east of Scalpay
?	1850	Cargo of timber. Found with stern and cabin burnt.
Lawrence O'Connor Doyle	1850	Schooner. Struck rock 6 miles off Scalpay.
Frederick Aae	1861	Schooner. From Montreal. Cargo of flour. Wreckage on W Scalpay.
Courier	1862	Cargo of timber. Driven from anchor at Scalpay.
Labuan	1864	Steamship. From Liverpool to Cronstadt. Cargo of cotton and coal. Struck sunken rock <i>Lag na Laire</i> near Scalpay.
Columba	1866	From Liverpool to Stavanger. Cargo of salt. Dismasted in harbour.
Harmony	1866	Schooner. Stranded off Scalpay.
Concordia	1878	Barque. From Liverpool to Cronstadt. Cargo of salt. Sank near lighthouse.
George & Jane	1884	Sloop. Cargo of herrings. Sank off Sound of Scalpay.
Abstainer	1884	Brigantine. From Larg to Newcastle. Cargo of limestone. Struck sunken rock off Scalpay.
Minerva	1884	Steamship. From Runcorn to Lerwick. Cargo of salt. Struck <i>Sgeir Graidich</i> .
St Clair	1885	Wooden lugger. Fishing.
Valkyrien	1888	Wooden barque. From Greenock to Christiania. Cargo of coal. Sank between Shiant Isles and Scalpay.
Johanna	1907	Steamship. Cargo of coal. Sank NE of Scalpay.
Heather Bell	1910	Smack. Cargo of salt and barrels. Stranded near new pier in Scalpay.

Milton	1922	Steam drifter. Cargo of cured herrings. Sank E of east Tarbert pier.
Parkmore	1929	Steam trawler (Oban)
Tolsa	1935	Steamship. Struck <i>Sgeir Graidich</i> off Scalpay
Headway	1941	Wooden steam drifter.
Thomas Altoft	1947	Steam trawler (Fleetwood). Struck <i>Sgeir Graidich</i> off Scalpay.
Cretetree	1953?	Concrete collier built 1919.
Etna	1954	Steamship. Struck <i>Sgeir Inoe</i> off Scalpay.
Boston Heron	1962	Steam trawler. Struck <i>Sgeir Stilamair</i> off Scalpay
Oliver Guite	1972	Steam trawler.
Golf Star	1995	Motor vessel. Stranded off Scalpay.
